For example, the emergence of artificial intelligence (AI) in medicine and dermatology, influencing diagnostic and therapeutic paths, represents a new challenge for the dermatologist, not only in the cynical field, but also in histopathology.

"Pavia incontra" is aimed at a wide audience, from medical students to doctors in training, general practitioners and specialists in the area. The plurality of topics covered offers a dynamic platform for knowledge exchange, collaboration and focus on recent research contributions in diagnosis and therapy. The monothematic lectures are complemented by short interactive sessions with presentations of paradigmatic clinical cases of rare diseases.

The meeting will take place in the evocative historical centre of Pavia, the heart of one of the oldest Italian and European universities, a mosaic of identities and symbols that show themselves in art and culture, in panoramas and monumental treasures, but also in food and wine and nature in the land that was once the home of the Lombards and the Visconti Family.
